- All stock placed for competition must be the property of the Exhibitor one month previous to the Show. This rule does not apply to classes marked "Open".
- All stock must be in the Showground no later than 9.00am.
- All stock entered for the Show must stand at their respective posts after judging, and, if not, they will be disqualified. The Society will not be responsible if they miss their class when judging is in progress.
- Occasionally classes may coincide. It is up to the competitor to decide which class they will go forward to.
- All Entries in classes governed by Teeth Qualifications to have their Mouths examined before being allowed into the judging ring.
- No stock to be loaded for removal until after the Champion of Champions is over, unless by special permission.
- Any Animal in the Schedule / Catalogue failing to turn out for the Champion of Champions will forfeit the Prize Money.
- All Prize Money unclaimed by the end of the Show will be forfeited.
- The Committee shall have power on their own initiative to deal with all questions as to the infringement or interpretation of the Rules or Regulations of the Society and their decision shall be final.
- In the event of the Show being cancelled refunds will only be given if request is accompanied by a Stamped Self Addressed envelope and must be received within 14 days of date of show.
An administration fee may be deducted.
- Protests: Protest must be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary on day of the Show, along with a deposit of £20, which will be forfeited if the objection is overruled, and the decision of the Committee in all cases of dispute to be final.
